Eco Smart

Replacing the rear wheel

Tools Required: Phillips Screwdriver, Long Nose Pliers, 10 mm wrench, Two 8 mm wrenches, Two 15 mm wrenches.

Note the sequence of the hardware before removing or replacing any parts from the unit.



With a Philips screwdriver, remove the three (5) screws on the chain guard.





2) Remove the chain guard.



3) Push the chain tensioner down and remove the chain from the wheel aprocket.





4) With a long nose piler, remove the end cap from the brake cable. Do not threw the end cap.



i) With a 10 mm wrench, loose the brake cable



enchor bolt and disconnect the cable.





6) With two (2) 8 mm wrenches, remove the cable guide bracket from the frame and brake plate. Keep all the herdware together.



7) With two (2) 15 mm wrenches, loosen the axie nuts from the wheel. Slide the wheel forward, remove the chain from the sprocket and remove the wheel. Note the sequence of the hardware.
